A broad coalition of environmental and development organizations organized "Planet Diversity," which took place during negotiations on the Convention on Biological Diversity in May 2008 in Bonn, Germany. More than 700 participants from 100 countries discussed the future of agriculture and food. As the official negotiations began, 6,000 people demonstrated against genetic engineering and patenting of life forms, for local agriculture and the protection of biological diversity. Afterwards 15,000 people visited the Festival of Diversity on the banks of the Rhine River. Well known activists like Vandana Shiva, Farida Akhter and Florianne Koechlin, as well as farmwomen and scientists, artists and peace activists and concerned mothers make it clear: the future of our natural world, agriculture and food cannot be saved by technical fixes, but should be lived, enjoyed, respected and developed by us all: regionally, fairly and without genetic engineering!
